



Ms. Anna Sirica has her MS degree in Economics and Business (University "Federico II" Naples), a II level University Master Degree in Management and Public Economy (Sapienza University, Rome) and II level University Master Degree in Human Resources Communication, relationships and Management, School of Psychology-Gestalt (Sapienza University, Rome). Since May 2015, after a national search, she has been named in her current position as Director General of the Italian Space Agency (ASI). Previously, she has been holding several high level positions in administrative, economics and financial affairs for some of the main Italian Research Institutes and Universities: she served as chief administrative officer for Budget, Accounting, Procurements, Fiscal Affairs and Assets of the National Institute for Nuclear Physics (INFN) since June 2012. She has been working for the National Institute for Astrophysics (INAF), where she served as Chief Budget and Financial Officer (since October 2011), Secretary-General in the Technical Secretary of the President (since January 2012) and in other management functions as acting head of Staff Remunerations and tax compliance office, head of budget and financial planning office, administrative officer (from 2002 to 2006). In the Council for Agricultural Research she served as chief accounting and budget officer from 2006 to 2011. She was Administrative Secretary of the Math Department at the Milan University (1999-2002), where she was part of the budget commission for the transition to accruals based general accounts, and administrative assistant and Operating manager for the development of Pole of Cremona at the Polytechnic of Milan (1997-1999).

She has gained a long-standing experience in the economic, financial and administrative management of public research and development activities, as well as of the public governance of national research and universities in Italy. She is further attending the course of the Gestalt School for professional counselling and counselor in Human Resources management.
