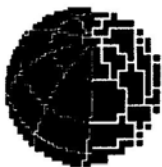

Dr Neri has also kindly contributed his time as a local expert volcanologist on numerous fieldcourses to Mt Etna led by Dr Rust, as well as visiting SEES to discuss research and give a guest lecture. Moreover, and increasingly over recent years, he has made a major contribution in advising and providing data for SEES MSc Geological Hazards students while pursuing their thesis projects on Mt Etna. In fact, several of these students have also been provided with desk space at the INGV offices in Catania.
The MoU is designed to bring more formal recognition to this long-standing informal collaboration.
